Rules/Guide Lines

To preserve the beauty and pleasures of Trump Lake and its shores for this generation and those to come

Town ordinance prohibits the use of motorboats or personal watercraft speeds over **slow-no-wake*** Sunday, Monday, Tuesday and Thursday, before 10 a.m. or after 4 p.m. Wednesday before 10 a.m. or after Dusk, Friday and Saturday before 10 a.m. or after 5 p.m.

Water skiers are cautioned to stay at a SAFE DISTANCE from shore lines, piers, swimmers and other boats. Maintain **counter clockwise traffic** for all fast boating and skiing.

State law prohibits speeds over slow-no-wake* within 100 feet of docks, rafts, piers, buoys and swimmers.

No swimming after 10 p.m. at the public beach.

Live, rough fish, minnows, goldfish etc., should not be thrown into the lake.

Since soap and detergents change the oxygen content in water and hasten the formation of algae and similar material. BATHING, HAIR WASHING AND LAUNDERING IN THE LAKE IS ILLEGAL.

Existing out houses, filter beds and septic systems should be maintained to prevent offensive odors.

A speed limit of 25 miles per hour around the lake road must be maintained. ATV speed limit 10 miles per hour. Be considerate at all times to walkers and children near or on the road.
