

Trump Lake Protective Association Rules & Guidelines

Purpose: To preserve the beauty of Trump Lake and its surrounding shores for this generation and those to come.

Town ordinance prohibits the use of motorboats or personal watercraft speeds over Slow-No-Wake Speed* before 10 AM and after 4 PM on Sunday, Monday, Tuesday and Thursday. On Wednesday before 10 AM and after Sunset. On Friday and Saturday before 10:00 AM and after 5:00 PM.

State law prohibits speeds over Slow-No-Wake Speed* within 100 feet of docks, rafts, piers, buoys, and swimmers.

Water skiers are cautioned to stay at a SAFE DISTANCE from shorelines, piers, swimmers, and other boats. All water skiing and other fast boat traffic will maintain a counter- clockwise direction.

The public swimming beach is open daily. The beach closes at 10:00 PM.

Any live fish from other lakes, rough fish, goldfish, etc. should not be thrown in Trump Lake.

Since soap and detergents change the oxygen content in water and enhance the formation of algae and similar material; BATHING, HAIR WASHING, AND LAUNDERING IN THE LAKE IS ILLEGAL.

All existing houses/cottages with filter beds and septic systems should be maintained to prevent offensive or foul odors.

On the roads around the lake a speed limit of 25 miles per hour must be maintained. The ATV/UTV speed limit is 10 miles per hour. Be aware of and considerate to walkers on the road and children playing near the road.

Disturbances of the peace, trespassing, and traffic violations on Trump Lake and on the roads are to be reported to the Forest County Sheriff. Please phone (715) 478- 3331. For emergencies call 911. The DNR Warden phone is (715) 889-0379.
